## Narrative:

On July 21, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Kenneth Smith (SA Smith) canvassed homes in the area of 5760 US 62, Hillsboro, Ohio, in regards to an Officer-Involved Critical Incident involving Highland County Sheriff's Office deputies and Richard Poulin that occurred on July 17, 2022, in the early morning hours.

SA Smith went to 5731 US 62 in Hillsboro, Ohio, and spoke with Brenda Lovett. Mrs. Lovett stated that they did not hear or see anything on the early morning of July 17, 2022, and found out about the incident the next day on Facebook.

SA Smith then went next door to 5701 US 62 and spoke quickly with Katie Greer, who was in her vehicle leaving. Mrs. Greer stated that they did not hear or see anything related to the OICI.

SA Smith then went to 5681 Concord Road, Hillsboro, Ohio, which had a direct view of the roadway where the OICI occurred. No one was home and SA Smith left a business card in the door.

On July 22, 2022, SA Smith received an email from Karen Marler (kmarler6182@gmail.com) of 5681 Concord Road, which stated the following:

"Hello you left a card in our door. We live at 5681 Concord Rd, Hillsboro, OH 45133. Next to the cemetery. We did not hear or see anything that night. My husband and I did not know about the shooting until the next day ok Facebook. If you have any other questions please call. Karen 937-402-6182 and Kurt 937-402-6181. Thank you"
