REFERENDUM PETITION

To the Secretary of State and Attorney General of Ohio: Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code § 3519.01(B), the undersigned electors of the State of Ohio, numbering in excess of one thousand, hereby submit to each of you Sections 1 and 2 of Substitute House Bill Number 319 of the 129th General Assembly (the "Act") and a summary of the same.

TITLE

A referendum petition on Sections 1 and 2 of Substitute House Bill Number 319 passed by the 129th General Assembly (the "Act"), the title and legislative history of the Act being:

AN ACT

To enact new section 3521.01 and to repeal section 3521.01 of the Revised Code and to amend Section 247.10 of Am. Sub. H.B. 153 of the 129th General Assembly to establish Congressional district boundaries for the state based on the 2010 decennial census of Ohio, to require boards of elections to notify electors of their new districts and new precincts for the 2012 primary election, and to make an appropriation.

Legislative History:

Introduced on 09/13/2011 as House Bill 319; Reported by the Ohio House of Representatives State Government & Elections Committee on 09/15/2011; Passed by the Ohio House of Representatives on 09/15/2011; Introduced in the Ohio Senate on 09/19/2011; Substitute bill reported by the Senate Government Oversight and Reform Committee on 09/21/2011; Passed by the Ohio Senate on 09/21/2011; Concurrence by the Ohio House of Representatives on 09/21/2011; Signed into law by the Governor on 09/26/2011; filed by the Governor with the Secretary of State on 09/26/2011

SUMMARY

Sections 1 and 2 of Substitute House Bill 319 repeal existing Ohio Revised Code Section 3521.01, which establishes boundaries for Ohio's 18 congressional districts, and enacts boundaries for Ohio's 16 congressional districts based on the 2010 decennial census of Ohio.

If a majority of the voters vote to not approve the Sections 1 and 2 of the Act, then the changes enacted in Sections 1 and 2 of the Act will not take effect and the prior version of the affected laws will remain in effect.
