On Thursday, July 21, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent James Poole (SA Poole) requested, via email, the Internal Affair records of Major and Sergeant from the Guernsey County Sheriff's Office (GCSO). The purpose of the request was to obtain all relevant information of the deputies involved in the Officer-Involved Critical Incident that occurred on June 24, 2022.
