Narrative:

On June 18, 2023, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) was requested by the Lebanon Police Department and Warren County Sheriff's Department, to investigate an Officer-Involved Critical Incident (OICI) that occurred in Lebanon, Ohio, between the subject, Dione Kellum, and Lebanon Police Department and Warren County Sheriff's Department.

BCI Agents were advised that Kellum had initially been transported to Atrium Medical Center before being taken to Miami Valley Hospital in Dayton. On June 18, 2023, Special Agent Lauren Frazier responded to Miami Valley Hospital. SA Frazier obtained information that Kellum was currently being treated in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) Room# 4538.

SA Frazier responded to ICU Room# 4538 and was met by Lebanon Police Officer Travis Shaver, who was maintaining custody of Kellum. SA Frazier spoke with medical staff, who advised that Kellum had "life threatening" injuries, was brain dead, and was not going to survive his injuries. SA Frazier observed Kellum had at least two gunshot wounds, including to the head and torso. SA Frazier was unable to obtain photographs or obtain additional information due to medical personnel performing a procedure.

SA Frazier collected two hospital bags containing clothing items found in possession of Kellum at the time of the incident. These items were transported by SA Frazier to the incident location and given to BCI Crime Scene Special Agent Chad Holcomb.

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
