CONSENT JUDGMENT

(A-24. pg 837)

The Complaint having been filed on October 5, 1982, and the parties having consented to this Consent Judgment,

NOW, THEREFORE, before the taking of testimony, upon the pleadings, and upon consent of the parties, it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

I.

This Court has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of this action. The complaint states a claim upon which relief may be granted under Chapter 1509, Revised Code.

II.

This Consent Judgment applies to Defendant Behymer, his agents, employees, and successors, and to all persons, firms, corporations, and other entities having notice of the Judgment and acting in privity with Defendant Behymer.

III

Defendant Behymer is ordered to refrain from drilling and operating any oil or gas well without first obtaining a permit for the well from the Division of Oil and Gas.

IV

Defendant Behymer shall pay a civil penalty of two hundred fifty dollars. Payment shall be made within ~~ten~~ ^{thirty} days of entry of this Consent Judgment by delivering to counsel for the State a check in that amount payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio." Defendant shall pay court costs.




The Court retains jurisdiction for the purpose of making any order or decree necessary to carry out this Judgment.
