This matter came on for hearing this 26th day of November, 1986. The Defendant was represented by counsel, Attorney Stephen C. Rodeheffer. The State of Ohio, City of Portsmouth, was represented by William T. Marshall, City Prosecutor. Willie H. Keeton having entered a plea of guilty to said charge, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Defendant be fined the sum of \$10,000.00 and costs and sentenced to ninety (90) days in the Scioto County Jail. The Defendant shall be given 120 days from this date to pay all fines and costs in this matter.

It is further ordered that \$8,000.00 of the fine be suspended and that the ninety (90) day jail sentence be suspended and that the Defendant be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years.

The terms of this probation shall be that the Defendant, Willie H. Keeton, pay all fines and costs by March 25, 1987 and that there be no further violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.03 and Ohio Administrative Code Section 3745-19-04 (A).
