The Complaint having been filed on October 28, 1982,
and Plaintiff and Defendants by their respective attorneys
having consented to this Consent Judgment;

THEREFORE, before the taking of any testimony, upon the
pleadings and upon the consent of the parties hereto, the
Court hereby makes the following findings:

1. The Court has jurisdiction over the parties and the
subject matter of this case. The Complaint states a claim
upon which relief can be granted against Defendants under
Section 1521.05 of the Revised Code.

2. As described in the Complaint, during a time previous
to the filing of this Complaint Defendants failed to submit
well logs to the Division of Water within thirty days after
drilling, boring, digging, and/or deepening wells, despite
the requirement in Revised Code Section 1521.05 that they file
such logs.

3. Subsequent to the filing of the Complaint, Defendants filed well logs for all wells for which they possessed records of drilling, boring, digging, and/or deepening.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, in accordance with the agreement of the parties, that judgment be entered in this action as follows:

1. The provision of this Consent Judgment shall apply to and be binding upon the parties to this action, their agents, servants, employees, and successors.

2. Defendants are permanently enjoined from violating Revised Code Section 1521.05.

3. The Court retains jurisdiction of this case for the purpose of making any order or decree which it may deem at any time to be necessary to carry out this judgment.


4. Defendants shall pay Court costs.
