This cause came on to be heard upon an appeal from the final decision of the Ohio Unemployment Compensation Review Commission.

The Court affirms the Review Commission Decision finding that Appellee, James M. Akins, is entitled to unemployment compensation benefits based on his separation from employment.

The Court further finds that Appellant, The Ohio State University, is not the separating employer. Therefore, pursuant to R.C. 4141.24(D)(2), The Ohio State University is not chargeable for the benefits. All charges to the account of The Ohio State University are to be charged to the mutualized account and any charges filed against The Ohio State University for this claim will be reimbursed or credited by ODJFS through the mutualized account.
