The default judgment motion of Appellant Neal C. Folck filed herein on the 3rd day of October, 2013 is hereby DISMISSED as a improper pleading filed in the wrong court in this case number.

Upon a review of the submitted Unemployment Compensation Review Commission certified transcript of the record of the proceeding herein on the 9th day of August, 2012 decision, motions, briefs and memorandum of the parties, the Court finds Folck quit employment with Keffer without just cause.

The Court finds clearly from the evidence submitted that Folck's own actions created his situation and rendered him ineligible for unemployment compensations benefits.
