FINAL JUDGMENT ENTRY OF REMAND

This case came on for consideration as a statutory unemployment appeal that was filed by Appellant, Timothy James (James), under R.C. 4141.282. James appeals from the final *Decision* of the Unemployment Compensation Review Commission (UCRC) dated March 6, 2013 that dismissed his appeal of an adverse *ODJFS Redetermination of Benefits* dated July 23, 2012 on the basis that his appeal was untimely filed under R.C. 4141.281(B) and R.C. 4141.281(D)(9). For the record, the *ODJFS Redetermination of Benefits* dated July 23, 2012 denied the unemployment claim of James on the basis that he was discharged from his employment by Appellee, Federal Express Corporation, for just cause under R.C. 4141.29(D)(2)(a).

Accordingly, after due consideration of the evidence in the certified record, the Court hereby ORDERS that this case be REMANDED to the UCRC pursuant to R.C. 4141.282(H) for an inperson de novo evidentiary hearing to be held by the UCRC in the claim under R.C. 4141.281 on the sole issue of whether James was discharged by Appellee, Federal Express Corporation, for juntegraphs under R.C. 4141.29(D)(2)(a). Costs to Appellant.
