JUDGMENT ENTRY GRANTING DIRECTOR'S AND APPELLEES' MOTIONS TO DISMISS APPELLANT'S NOTICE OF APPEAL

Now before the Court are the Director of Ohio Department of Job and Family Services' ("Director") and Appellees Anne Grady Corporation and Velma Thomas' ("Appellees") motions to dismiss Appellant Dawn R. Willis' ("Appellant") August 13, 2014, Notice of Appeal of the Unemployment Compensation Review Commission's July 23, 2014, decision finding that Appellant had quit her employment without just cause and, thus, was not entitled to unemployment compensation benefits. The instant motions to dismiss maintain that the Court lacks subject-matter jurisdiction over Appellant's Notice of Appeal due to its failure to name the Director as an appellee as required by R.C. 4141.282(D). While Appellant has not yet filed a response to either of these motions, the requisite time frame within which to do so has passed.

In any event, upon due consideration, the Court finds the instant motions to dismiss for lack



of subject-matter jurisdiction to be well-taken and hereby GRANTS said motions.¹ Accordingly, Appellant's Notice of Appeal is hereby DISMISSED.
