FINAL JUDGMENT ENTRY OF REMAND

This case came on for consideration as a statutory unemployment appeal that was filed by Appellant Daniel Carter (Carter) under R.C. 4141.282. Carter appeals from the *Decision* of the Unemployment Compensation Review Commission (UCRC) dated August 6, 2014.

The UCRC dismissed Carter's appeal of an adverse *ODJFS Redetermination of Benefits* dated May 2, 2014 on the basis that Carter failed to appear at the hearing that was scheduled in his claim on June 12, 2014. See R.C. 4141.281(D)(5).

After due consideration, the Court hereby finds that Carter has shown good cause for his failure to appear at the hearing on June 12, 2014. Therefore, the Court hereby ORDERS that the claim be REMANDED to the UCRC under R.C. 4141.282(H) for a *de novo* hearing to be held on the issue of whether Carter was ineligible for unemployment benefits on the basis that he was *not* available for and actively seeking suitable work under R.C. 4141.29(A)(4)(a). Finally, the Court hereby vacates the *Journal Entry* that was filed on April 20, 2015. Costs to Appellant.
