This matter came on for hearing on an appeal of the administrative decision of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services Unemployment Compensation Review Commission ("UCRC"). UCRC held that Appellant Jonathan A. Freed ("Appellant") was not entitled to receive unemployment benefits. The reason that UCRC cited for this decision was that appellant received a large amount of deductible income when he separated from his employment with Ed Map Inc. UCRC also maintained that this separation pay exceeded his maximum weekly benefit amount.

This court has reviewed submissions of the parties and the record. Based on this the court finds that the decision of the UCRC which disallowed the Request for Review was not unlawful, unreasonable, or against the manifest weight of the evidence. As such, this court hereby affirms in all respects the decision of the UCRC. This is a final appealable order. A copy of this decision shall be served on all parties and attorneys.
