
The court has considered Defendant Director, Job and Family Services' motion to dismiss for lack of jurisdiction, filed January 11, 2016, and Defendant Signature Health's motion to dismiss for lack of subject matter jurisdiction, filed January 26, 2016. The court notes that the plaintiff failed to file briefs in opposition to the motions, and the time to do so has now passed.

The instant case is an appeal from a decision of the Unemployment Compensation Review Commission. In both motions, the defendants argue that the court lacks subject matter jurisdiction because the plaintiff's appeal was not timely filed, pursuant to R.C. 4141.282(A). To be timely, the appeal had to be filed by November 20, 2015. It was not filed until November 23, 2015.

Wherefore, the court finds that the defendants' motions to dismiss are well taken and they are both hereby granted. The plaintiff's complaint is hereby dismissed.
