

ORDER GRANTING MOTION
TO DISMISS

The court has considered Appellee Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicle's motion to dismiss, filed February 22, 2016. The court notes that the appellant failed to respond to the motion, and the time to do so has now expired.

The appellant filed an administrative appeal of a decision by the Bureau to suspend his driver's license for failure to maintain proof of insurance. In its motion, the Bureau requests that the appeal be dismissed for lack of subject matter jurisdiction because the appellant failed to comply with various statutory requirements, including failing to timely file the appeal.

The court finds that the motion is well-taken and ought to be granted. Wherefore, the appellant's administrative appeal is hereby dismissed.
