DECISION

This case comes before the Court on an Appeal filed by Glen Michael Needler December 18, 2015 challenging decisions of the Unemployment Compensation Review Commission November 5, 2015 and the Review Commission November 18, 2015. Service was perfected December 21 and December 24, 2015. A Motion to Set Briefing Schedule and an Entry establishing same was filed February 26, 2016.

Appellant did not file a Brief or a Reply to Appellee's Brief, which was filed April 14, 2016. In the absence of contrary evidence and upon a review of the file and Appellee's Brief, the Court finds that there is credible evidence in the record to support the findings of the Hearing Examiner and that the November 18, 2015 decision of the Review Commission is lawful, reasonable and not against the manifest weight of the evidence.

The decision of the Review Commission is affirmed.
