THIS MATTER IS BEFORE THE COURT ON APPELLANT HAMDA'S APPEAL OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES'S (THE "AGENCY") DECISION TO DISENROLL HER MINOR CHILD, ..., FROM THE OHIO HOME CARE WAIVER PROGRAM.

THE COURT HAS CAREFULLY REVIEWED APPELLANT'S BRIEF, APPELLEE'S BRIEF, APPELLANT'S REPLY, AND THE ACCOMPANYING CERTIFIED RECORD. THE COURT FINDS THAT THE AGENCY'S DECISION IS NOT SUPPORTED BY RELIABLE. PROBATIVE AND SUBSTANTIAL EVIDENCE. AND THUS IS NOT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAW. SPECIFICALLY, THE AGENCY'S FAILURE TO CONSIDER THE PHYSICIAN VERIFICATION PROVIDED BY DR. M. KATHLEEN SKOCH SUGGESTS A POTENTIAL VIOLATION OF DUE PROCESS RIGHTS.

THE COURT REVERSES THE AGENCY'S DECISION AND REMANDS THE WITHIN MATTER FOR FURTHER PROCEEDINGS IN WHICH THE AGENCY SHALL CONSIDER THIS OMITTED MEDICAL DOCUMENTATION.
