FINAL APPEALABLE ORDER

This is an appeal pursuant to R.C. 4141.282 from a Decision of the Unemployment Compensation Review Commission (Review Commission). This Court must affirm the Review Commission's decision unless the decision was unlawful, unreasonable, or against the manifest weight of the evidence. R.C. 4141.282(H). The Court's scope of review in this appeal is limited, and the Court is not to make factual findings or substitute its judgment for that of the Review Commission. *Irvine v. Unemployment Compensation Review Commission*, 19 Ohio St.3d 15, 18; *Simon v. Lake Geauga Printing Co.*, 69 Ohio St.2d 41, 45 (1982).

After reviewing the record, the Court finds that the Review Commission's Decision is not unlawful, unreasonable, or against the manifest weight of the evidence. Further, the Court takes notice that the Appellant neglected to file a brief in support of his appeal, and failed to file a reply to the Appellee's brief.

There is no just cause for delay as this is a final appealable order.

The Clerk shall mail a copy of this Judgment/Order to all counsel of record and to each party not in default who is not represented by counsel and make note of the service in the Appearance Docket.
