

This matter came on this day for consideration upon the appeal of CJW, Inc. from the State of Ohio Unemployment Compensation Review Commission's determination that Appellee's termination of employment was not for cause and that unemployment compensation should be awarded to Appellee. Appellant's challenge of errors includes that the termination was for cause, and that the decision was unlawful, unreasonable or against the manifest weight of the evidence.

Based on Appellant's testimony and documentary evidence, and Appellee's failure to appear or to substantiate his position in the writing submitted by Appellee, the court finds that the Commission's determination was against the manifest weight of the evidence and it hereby reverses the decision of the Commission.
