John J. Page, the Appellant in this case, was present in the Courtroom and represented by **Brad L. Hillyer**, Attorney at Law, Uhrichsville, Ohio. Appellee, Ohio Department of Public Safety, Ohio of Legal Services, was represented by **Joseph S. Hess**, Assistant Ohio Attorney General in the Office of Ohio Attorney General Mike DeWine, Columbus, Ohio.

The Court

FINDS that the 8/10/2017 Motion of Appellee Ohio Department of Public Safety, Office of Legal Services to Dismiss the 7/17/2017 Appeal of John J. Page for lack of subject matter jurisdiction is meritorious, appropriate, and should be Granted for the reasons that the Appellant failed to comply with R.C. 119.12 insofar as he did not file a Notice of Appeal with both the Department of Public Safety and this Court within the required fifteen (15) days of the mailing of the final order of [driver license] suspension. Appellant did not file a Notice of Appeal with the Appellee or the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles at all and did not comply with the deadline for filing his Notice of Appeal with this Court (fifteen (15) days) from the date of the mailing of the license suspension order.

It is therefore

ORDERED that the 8/10/2017 **Motion** of Appellee is **Granted.** The Appeal filed by John J. Page on 7/17/2017 is **dismissed with prejudice to refiling** for the reasons indicated above.

ORDERED that the Clerk of Courts shall close this case file and remove it from the pending case docket. All Court costs are assessed against Appellant for payment.
