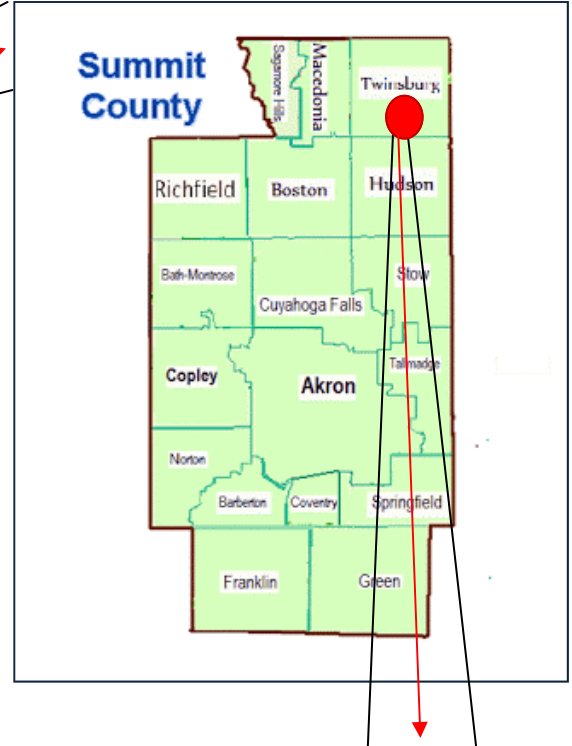
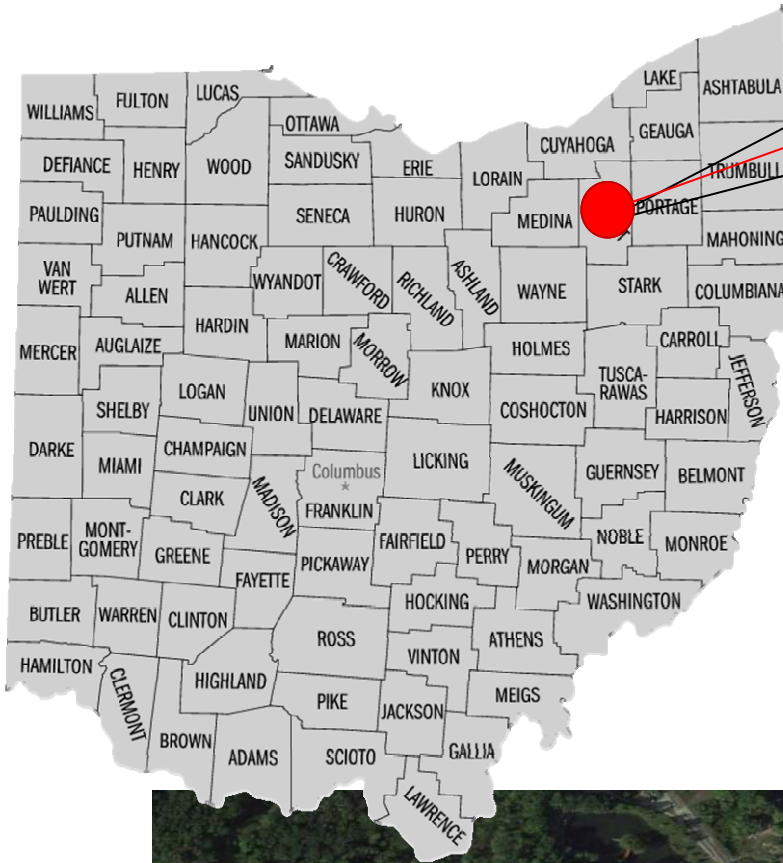
The Ohio Attorney General’s Bureau of Criminal Investigation and Summit County Medical Examiner’s Office are seeking assistance to help identify skeletal remains that were found on February 18, 1982. The remains were located behind a business located at 3047 Cannon Rd. in Twinsburg, Ohio. The decedent is believed to be that of an African American male between 20 and 30 years old. He was estimated to have been approximately 5’6” tall. Additional details such as weight, hair or eye color are unknown.

The image shown is a facial reconstruction completed by an Ohio BCI Forensic Artist. Items such as hair style are the artist’s estimations to complete the image and should not be considered as significant markers for identification.
