The Ohio Attorney General's Bureau of Criminal Investigation and Franklin County Coroner's Office are seeking assistance to help identify an unidentified person whose name has been unknown since November 28, 1999. The female was found in front of the Kahiki restaurant, located at 3583 East Broad Street in Columbus, Ohio. It is believed she died of natural causes. Her estimated age is between 20 and 50 years old. She was 5'7" and weighed 140 pounds. She had blue eyes and short, brown-red hair and was wearing a straw hat, blue coat, overalls, blue socks, sunglasses, and gray metal earrings.
