UPDATE: Unidentified Remains

The Ohio Attorney General's Bureau of Criminal Investigation and Hamilton County Coroner's Office are seeking assistance to identify a female who was located deceased on May 31, 2018. The female was located beside a playground near an apartment complex at 421 Glenwood Ave. in Cincinnati, Ohio. Investigators believe the decedent rested there for a few days prior to discovery.

Since her discovery investigators have completed a clay facial reconstruction, DNA testing, and genealogy. However, none of these efforts have yet rendered an identity.

Information from advanced DNA testing revealed that this female is of 100% European decent. With this new information and new technology, another effort is being made to help identify this Jane Doe. BCI's Forensic Artist worked with the Office of Academic Affairs Digital Learning (OAA DL) and the Advanced Computing Center for the Arts and Design (ACCAD) at the Ohio State University to generate additional digital images of what the individual may have looked like. Items such as hair style are estimations to complete the image and should not be considered as significant markers for identification. Limited options were available in the program used.

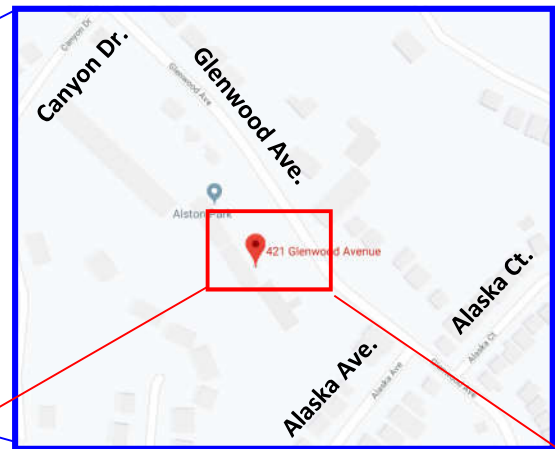
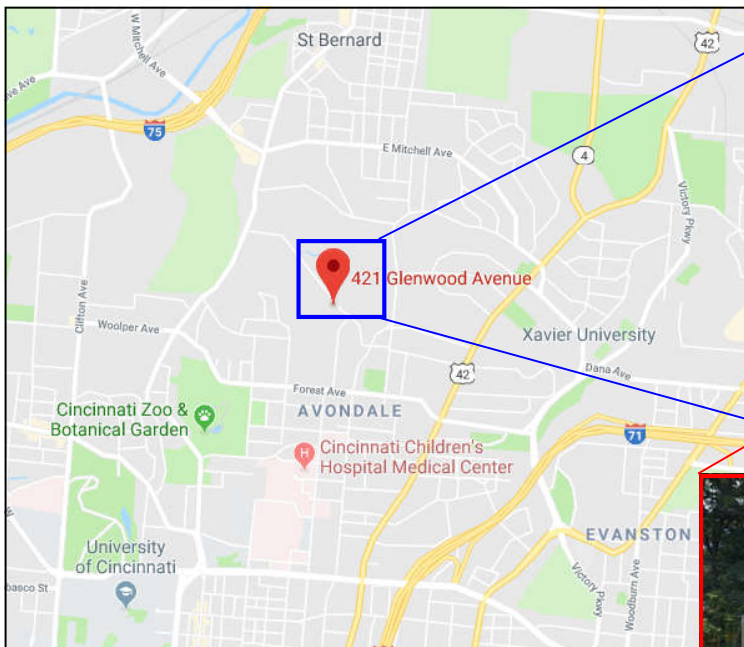


Personal Items: Hair Piece, Hair Ties & Earrings
