THE JURORS OF THE GRAND JURY of the State of Ohio, within and for the body of the County aforesaid, on their oaths, in the name and by the authority of the State of Ohio, do find and present that on or about the 9th day of July, 2009, at Auglaize County, Ohio, the said CHRISTINE ANN STEINKE knowing the person has no privilege to do so, and with purpose to defraud or knowing that the person is facilitating a fraud, did falsify, destroy, remove, conceal, alter, deface, or mutilate any writing, computer software, data, or record and the writing, data, computer software, or record is kept by or belongs to a local, state, or federal governmental entity. Said act is a felony of the third degree in violation of Ohio Revised Code Title 29, §2913.42(A)(1)(B)(4), and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

COUNT TWO

COUNT FOURTEEN



Said act is a felony of the second degree in violation of Ohio Revised Code Title 29, §2921.41(A)(1), and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

COUNT FIFTEEN

THE JURORS OF THE GRAND JURY of the State of Ohio, within and for the body of the County aforesaid, on their oaths, in the name and by the authority of the State of Ohio, do find and present that at or between the 9th day of July, 2009 and the 10th day of September, 2021, at Auglaize County, Ohio, the said CHRISTINE ANN STEINKE being a public official or party official, did commit any theft offense, as defined in Division (K) of Ohio Revised Code §2913.01, and the property or service involved is owned by this state, any other state, the United States, a county, a municipal corporation, a township, or any political subdivision, department, or agency of any of them, is owned by a political party, or is part of a political campaign fund and the value of the property or services stolen is \$150,000.00 or more and is less than \$750,000.00. Said act is a felony of the second degree in violation of Ohio Revised Code Title 29, §2921.41(A)(2), and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.




