CLEVELAND POLICE 2012 PURSUIT REPORT REVIEW

Summary

Pursuant to the investigation of the Officer Involved Shooting in East Cleveland on November 29, 2012, Cmdr. Chura of the Cleveland Police Department turned over copies of Cleveland Police Vehicle Pursuit Reports from 2012. The reports were reviewed and submitted to the case file.



Details

Eighty-four (84) reports were turned over to BCI for review. These reports dates spanned 01/01/12 to 12/19/12. It should be noted that there were two versions of these reports. There appears to be an older version along with one that includes "GPO 3.2.02 Appendix Revised July 2010" printed on the top. In reviewing these reports it was found that:

- 12 pursuits were listed as "Supervisor Termination".
- 2 pursuits were listed as "Officer Termination".
- 22 pursuits ended with the suspects crashing.
- 2 pursuits ended with a patrol car crashing.
- 30 pursuits ended with suspects bailing out on foot.
- 14 pursuits ended with the suspects stopping
- 2 pursuits ended by "Police Intervention".

Of these reports, it was learned that:

- 67 pursuits ended in the District they started in.
- 7 pursuits ended in a District other than where they started.
- 4 pursuits left the jurisdiction of Cleveland.
- 1 pursuit was initiated by another agency and went through the City of Cleveland.
- 3 reports list that officers in a pursuit violated policy.
