12/19/2012 REVIEW VIDEO SURVEILLANCE FROM MAX HAYES SCHOOL

Summary

On December 19, 2012 Special Agent Najmulski was requested to review video surveillance from the Max Hayes School; a division of the Cleveland Metro School District. S/A Najmulski viewed the video in an attempt to locate footage of a police chase resulting in an officer involved shooting on November 29, 2012.

Details

Special Agent Najmulski viewed the one hour video and observed the security camera to overlook a parking lot. Just beyond the parking lot a street can be seen with light traffic flow.

Twenty- one minutes and fifty-five seconds into the footage, a white police car is observed to travel to the left of the screen. No emergency lights are observed to be activated. Thirty-four minutes and forty-four seconds into the footage, a lone emergency vehicle with activated lights travels to the left of the screen. The lights wash the vehicle out in the video and it is hard to distinguish if it is a police vehicle.

At forty minutes into the video, a lone emergency vehicle travels to the right of the screen with emergency lights activated. At forty-two minutes and thirty-five seconds, one emergency vehicle is traveling to the left of the screen with emergency lights activated. In both of these incidents the emergency lights wash out the vehicle and it is unknown if the images captured are police vehicles.

In each of the above references the vehicle seen was not observed to be following or chasing anyone.
