Samuel Nicholas Zawosky, on or about the 10th day of September, 2020, in the county of Warren or another county whereby venue is properly placed in Warren County aforesaid, did with purpose to deprive the owner, Justin Ward, of property or services, to wit: \$32,500, knowingly obtain or exert control over either the property or services beyond the scope of the express or implied consent of the owner or person authorized to give consent in violation of Ohio Revised Code §2913.02(A)(2), 2913.02(B)(2), **Grand Theft**, a felony of the fourth degree.

FURTHERMORE, the property or services stolen is valued at seven thousand five hundred dollars or more and less than one hundred fifty thousand dollars.

The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

Count Two - Grand Theft F4

The Grand Jurors do further find and present:




