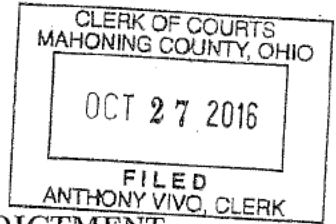

THE JURORS OF THE MAHONING COUNTY GRAND JURY of the State of Ohio on their oaths, in the name and authority of the State of Ohio, do find and present that:

COUNT 1

On or about 4-27-2015 through 8-9-2016, in a continuing course of conduct in the County of Mahoning, the State of Ohio, the Defendants, JONATHAN CENTENO, EDWARD BLACKMON, AARON MCGUIRE, EDWARD MCELROY and JOSE SUAREZ did while associated with an enterprise, did conduct or participate in, either directly or indirectly, the affairs of the enterprise through a pattern of corrupt activity. The defendants engaged in, conspired to engage in, attempted to engage in, or coerced another to engage in violations of the law including, but not limited to, Trafficking in Marijuana, Complicity to Traffic in Marijuana, and Possession of Marijuana, as set out in the subsequent counts and incorporated as fully restated herein. At least one of the incidents of corrupt activity is a felony of the THIRD degree or higher. This is in violation of 2923.32(A)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to-wit: ENGAGING IN A PATTERN OF CORRUPT ACTIVITY, constitutes a felony of the FIRST Degree.

(1) round in chamber; 44 SPL Bulldog loaded with (5) ROUNDS; Hornady Ammo; (15) rounds 44 and (11) rounds 9mm; .38 Spl revolver, Smith and Wesson (6) live rounds from cylinder and (6) additional rounds from holster; \$420.00 US currency; Nylon gun case with blue rubber gloves and cleaning wipes; Shipping labels; Miscellaneous Documents; Press, (1) utility knife, (1) beater, (1) jack, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 2941.1417 and 2981.

COUNT 2

On or about 4-27-15, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, AARON MCGUIRE did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount less than 200 grams, in the vicinity of a *school*, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(3)(b) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a Felony of the FOURTH degree.

COUNT 3

On or about 5-1-2015, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, AARON MCGUIRE did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount less than 200 grams, in the vicinity of a *school*, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(3)(b) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a Felony of the FOURTH degree.

COUNT 4

On or about 5-7-2015, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, AARON MCGUIRE did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount less than 200 grams, in the vicinity of a *school*, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(3)(b) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a Felony of the FOURTH degree.

COUNT 5

On or about 10-21-2015, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, JONATHAN CENTENO did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, marijuana or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount that equals or exceeds 200 grams but less than 1 kilogram, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(3)(c) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a Felony of the FOURTH degree.

COUNT 6

On or about 10-27-2015, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, JONATHAN CENTENO did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount that equals or exceeds 200 grams but less than 1 kilogram, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(3)(c) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a Felony of the FOURTH degree.

COUNT 7

On or about 11-2-15, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, JONATHAN CENTENO did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount less than 200 grams, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(3)(a) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a Felony of the FIFTH degree.

COUNT 8

On or about 12-16-2015, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, JONATHAN CENTENO did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount that equals or exceeds 200 grams but less than 1 kilogram, in the vicinity of a *juvenile*, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(3)(c) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a Felony of the THIRD degree.

COUNT 9

On or about 1-8-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, JONATHAN CENTENO did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount less than 200 grams, in the vicinity of a *juvenile*, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(3)(b) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a Felony of the FOURTH degree.

COUNT 10

On or about 4-3-2016 through 4-14-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, JONATHAN CENTENO and EDWARD MCELROY did knowingly prepare for shipment, ship, transport, deliver, prepare for distribution, or distribute, marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, when JONATHAN CENTENO and EDWARD MCELROY knows or has reasonable cause to believe that the marijuana is intended for sale or resale by JONATHAN CENTENO and EDWARD MCELROY or another person, in an amount that equals or exceeds 1 kilogram but less than 5 kilograms, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(2)(C)(3)(d) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a Felony of the THIRD degree.

COUNT 11

On or about 8-9-2016, in the County of Mahoning, the State of Ohio, JONATHAN CENTENO did knowingly obtain, possess, or use a drug, Marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount that equals or exceeds 1 kilogram, but is less than 5 kilograms, in violation of Section 2925.11(A)(C)(3)(d) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA, constitutes a felony of the THIRD Degree.

COUNT 12

On or about 3-3-2016, in the County of Mahoning, the State of Ohio, EDWARD MCELROY did knowingly obtain, possess, or use a drug, Marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount that equals or exceeds 1 kilogram, but is less than 5 kilograms, in violation of Section 2925.11(A)(C)(3)(d) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA, constitutes a felony of the THIRD Degree.

COUNT 13

On or about 3-9-2016, in the County of Mahoning, the State of Ohio, EDWARD MCELROY did knowingly obtain, possess, or use a drug, Marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount that equals or exceeds 1 kilogram, but is less than 5 kilograms, in violation of Section 2925.11(A)(C)(3)(d) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA, constitutes a felony of the THIRD Degree.

COUNT 14

On or about 3-10-2016, in the County of Mahoning, the State of Ohio, EDWARD MCELROY did knowingly obtain, possess, or use a drug, Marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount that equals or exceeds 1 kilogram, but is less than 5 kilograms, in violation of Section 2925.11(A)(C)(3)(d) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA, constitutes a felony of the THIRD Degree.

COUNT 15

On or about 3-11-2016, in the County of Mahoning, the State of Ohio, EDWARD MCELROY did knowingly obtain, possess, or use a drug, Marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount that equals or exceeds 1 kilogram, but is less than 5 kilograms, in violation of Section 2925.11(A)(C)(3)(d) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA, constitutes a felony of the THIRD Degree.

COUNT 16

On or about 4-15-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, EDWARD MCELROY did knowingly attempt to prepare for shipment, ship, transport, deliver, prepare for distribution, or distribute a drug, Marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount that equals or exceeds 1 kilogram, but is less than 5 kilograms, when ED MCELROY knew or had reasonable cause to believe that the controlled substance is intended for resale by ED MCELROY or another person, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(2)(C)(3)(d) and 2923.02(A) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: ATTEMPTED TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a felony of the FOURTH Degree.

COUNT 17

On or about 5-20-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, EDWARD MCELROY did knowingly attempt to prepare for shipment, ship, transport, deliver, prepare for distribution, or distribute a drug, Marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount that equals or exceeds 200 grams, but less than 1 kilogram, when EDWARD MCELROY knew or had reasonable cause to believe that the controlled substance is intended for resale by EDWARD MCELROY or another person, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(2)(C)(3)(d) and 2923.02(A) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: ATTEMPTED TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a felony of the FIFTH Degree.

COUNT 18

On or about 1-22-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, EDWARD BLACKMON did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, marijuana or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, that equals or exceeds 200 grams but less than 1 kilogram, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(3)(c) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a Felony of the FOURTH degree.

COUNT 19

On or about 2-2-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, EDWARD BLACKMON did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, that equals or exceeds 200 grams but less than 1 kilogram, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(3)(c) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a Felony of the FOURTH degree.

COUNT 20

On or about 2-16-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, EDWARD BLACKMON did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, that equals or exceeds 200 grams but less than 1 kilogram, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(3)(c) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a Felony of the FOURTH degree.

COUNT 21

On or about 5-20-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, EDWARD BLACKMON did knowingly attempt to prepare for shipment, ship, transport, deliver, prepare for distribution, or distribute a drug, Marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount that equals or exceeds 1 kilogram, but is less than 5 kilograms, when EDWARD BLACKMON knew or had reasonable cause to believe that the controlled substance is intended for resale by EDWARD BLACKMON or another person, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(2)(C)(3)(d) and 2923.02(A) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: ATTEMPTED TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a felony of the FOURTH Degree.

COUNT 22

On or about 8-1-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, EDWARD BLACKMON did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount that equals or exceeds 200 grams but less than 1 kilogram, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(3)(c) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a Felony of the FOURTH degree.

COUNT 23

On or about 8-9-16, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, EDWARD BLACKMON, did knowingly obtain, possess, or use a drug, TRAMADOL, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing Tramadol, a Schedule IV controlled substance and the offender has been previously convicted of a drug abuse offense in violation of Section 2925.11(A)(C)(2)(a) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: POSSESSION OF DRUGS, constitutes a felony of the FIFTH Degree.

(1) round in chamber; 44 SPL Bulldog loaded with (5) ROUNDS; Hornady Ammo; (15) rounds 44 and (11) rounds 9mm; .38 Spl revolver, Smith and Wesson (6) live rounds from cylinder and (6) additional rounds from holster; \$420.00 US currency; Nylon gun case with blue rubber gloves and cleaning wipes; Shipping labels; Miscellaneous Documents; Press, (1) utility knife, (1) beater, (1) jack, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 2941.1417 and 2981.

COUNT 24

On or about 8-9-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, EDWARD BLACKMON, without being relieved from disability as provided in Section 2923.14 of the Revised Code, knowingly did acquire, have, carry, or use any firearm or dangerous ordnance, to wit: 4 Kel Tec 9mm SN:SPR&& with (4) Rounds In MAG (1) round in chamber; 44 SPL Bulldog loaded with (5) ROUNDS; Hornady Ammo; (15) rounds 44 and (11) rounds 9mm; .38 Spl revolver, Smith and Wesson (6) live rounds from cylinder and (6) additional rounds from holster, and had been convicted of a felony offense involving the illegal possession, use, sale, administration, distribution, or trafficking in any drug of abuse, in violation of Section 2923.13(A)(3) of the Ohio Revised code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: HAVING WEAPONS WHILE UNDER DISABILITY, constitutes a felony of the THIRD Degree.

COUNT 25

On or about 5-9-16, in the County of Mahoning, and the State of Ohio, KENNETH SHARPE did knowingly sell or offer to sell a controlled substance, oxycodone/hydrochloride, "Roxicodone," or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing oxycodone/hydrochloride, "Roxicodone," included in Schedule II, the amount of drug is less than the bulk amount, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(1)(a) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: AGGRAVATED TRAFFICKING IN DRUGS, constitutes a felony of the FOURTH Degree.

COUNT 26

On or about 5-11-16, in the County of Mahoning, and the State of Ohio, KENNETH SHARPE did knowingly sell or offer to sell a controlled substance, oxycodone/acetaminophen, "Percocet," or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing oxycodone/acetaminophen, "Percocet," included in Schedule II, the amount of drug is less than the bulk amount, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(1)(a) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: AGGRAVATED TRAFFICKING IN DRUGS, constitutes a felony of the FOURTH Degree.

COUNT 27

On or about 1-8-2016 YEASHELLEY CENTENO did, as the owner, lessee, or occupant, or who has custody, control, or supervision, of premises or real estate, including vacant land, to wit: 844 Palmer Ave., Youngstown, OH 44502, knowingly permit such premises or real estate, including vacant land, to be used for the commission of a felony drug abuse offense, to wit: O.R.C. 2925.03(A)(1)/(2)(C)(3) Trafficking Marijuana, by another person, JONATHAN CENTENO, and the felony drug abuse offense referred to herein is a violation of Section 2925.02 or 2925.03 of the Revised Code, in violation of Section 2925.13(B)/ (C)(3) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to-wit: PERMITTING DRUG ABUSE, constitutes a felony of the FIFTH Degree.

COUNT 61

On or about 3-1-2016 YEASHELLEY CENTENO did, as the owner, lessee, or occupant, or who has custody, control, or supervision, of premises or real estate, including vacant land, to wit: 844 Palmer Ave., Youngstown, OH 44502, knowingly permit such premises or real estate, including vacant land, to be used for the commission of a felony drug abuse offense, to wit: O.R.C. 2925.03(A)(1)/(2)(C)(3) Trafficking Marijuana, by another person, JONATHAN CENTENO, and the felony drug abuse offense referred to herein is a violation of Section 2925.02 or 2925.03 of the Revised Code, in violation of Section 2925.13(B)/ (C)(3) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to-wit: PERMITTING DRUG ABUSE, constitutes a felony of the FIFTH Degree.

COUNT 62

On or about 3-14-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, WAYNE MARTIN did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, heroin, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, in an amount that equals or exceeds 5 grams, but is less than 10 grams. This is in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(6)(d) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN HEROIN, constitutes a felony of the THIRD Degree.

COUNT 63

On or about 3-29-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, WAYNE MARTIN, without being relieved from disability as provided in Section 2923.14 of the Revised Code, knowingly did acquire, have, carry, or use any firearm or dangerous ordnance, to wit: a firearm, and had been convicted of a felony offense involving the illegal possession, use, sale, administration, distribution, or trafficking in any drug of abuse, in violation of Section 2923.13(A)(3) of the Ohio Revised code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: HAVING WEAPONS WHILE UNDER DISABILITY, constitutes a felony of the THIRD Degree.

COUNT 64

On or about 4-1-16, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, WAYNE MARTIN did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, marijuana or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount that equals or exceeds 200 grams, but is less than 1 kilogram, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(3)(c) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a Felony of the FOURTH degree.

COUNT 65

On or about 4-1-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, WAYNE MARTIN and MARTWAN TREHARN did knowingly prepare for shipment, ship, transport, deliver, prepare for distribution, or distribute a drug, Marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marijuana, included in Schedule I, in an amount that equals or exceeds 200 grams but less than 1 kilogram, when WAYNE MARTIN

MARTWAN TREHARN knew or had reasonable cause to believe that the controlled substance is intended for resale by WAYNE MARTIN and MARTWAN TREHARN, or another person, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(2)(C)(3)(c) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a felony of the FOURTH Degree.

COUNT 66

On or about 4-3-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, WAYNE MARTIN, TERRELL MARTIN, and MARTWAN TREHARN knowingly, and acting with the kind of culpability required for the commission of an offense, did aid or abet another in committing Trafficking in Marijuana, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing Marijuana, a Schedule I Controlled Substance, in an amount that equals or exceeds 200 grams but less than 1 kilogram, a violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)/(2)(C)(3)(c) of the Ohio Revised Code, in violation of Section 2923.03(A)(1)/(2)/or (3) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: COMPLICITY TO TRAFFICKING IN MARIJUANA, constitutes a felony of the FOURTH Degree.

COUNT 67

On or about 4-12-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, WAYNE MARTIN did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, heroin, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, in an amount that equals or exceeds 5 grams, but is less than 10 grams. This is in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(6)(d) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN HEROIN, constitutes a felony of the THIRD Degree.

COUNT 68

On or about 5-3-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, WAYNE MARTIN did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, heroin, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, in an amount that equals or exceeds 5 grams, but is less than 10 grams. This is in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(6)(d) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN HEROIN, constitutes a felony of the THIRD Degree.

COUNT 69

On or about 5-28-2016 through on or about 5-29-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, WAYNE MARTIN, TELIA LAWSON, and CHRIS SIMMONS did knowingly obtain, possess, or use a drug, Heroin, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, in an amount equal to or exceeding 50 grams but less than 250 grams, in violation of Section 2925.11(A)(C)(6)(e) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: POSSESSION OF HEROIN, constitutes a felony of the FIRST Degree.

COUNT 70

On or about 5-29-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, WAYNE MARTIN did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, heroin, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, in an amount that equals or exceeds 5 grams, but is less than 10 grams. This is in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(6)(d) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN HEROIN, constitutes a felony of the THIRD Degree.

COUNT 71

On or about 6-3-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, WAYNE MARTIN and TELIA LAWSON did knowingly prepare for shipment, ship, transport, deliver, prepare for distribution, or distribute a drug, Heroin, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, when WAYNE MARTIN and TELIA LAWSON knew or had reasonable cause to believe that the controlled substance was intended for resale by WAYNE MARTIN and TELIA LAWSON or another person, in an amount that equals or exceeds 10 grams but is less than 50 grams in weight, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(2)(C)(6)(e) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN HEROIN, constitutes a felony of the SECOND Degree.

COUNT 72

On or about 6-6-2016 through 6-13-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, WAYNE MARTIN, RANDY BEAUSOLIEL, and ABRAHAM GARCIA MAGANA did knowingly attempt to prepare for shipment, ship, transport, deliver, prepare for distribution, or distribute a drug, Heroin, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, when WAYNE MARTIN, RANDY BEAUSOLIEL, and ABRAHAM GARCIA MAGANA knew or had reasonable cause to believe that the controlled substance was intended for resale by WAYNE MARTIN, RANDY BEAUSOLIEL, ABRAHAM GARCIA MAGANA or another person, in an amount that equals or exceeds 250 grams, in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(2)(C)(6)(g) and 2923.02(A) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: ATTEMPTED TRAFFICKING IN HEROIN, constitutes a felony of the SECOND Degree.

COUNT 73

On or about 6-10-2016, in the County of Mahoning, and State of Ohio, WAYNE MARTIN did knowingly, sell or offer to sell, heroin, or any compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, in an amount less than 200 grams. This is in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(1)(C)(6)(a) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to wit: TRAFFICKING IN HEROIN, constitutes a felony of the FIFTH Degree.

COUNT 74

On or between 3-4-2016 through 6-10-2016, as a continuing course of conduct in the County of Mahoning, the State of Ohio, the Defendant WAYNE MARTIN did while associated with an enterprise, did conduct or participate in, either directly or indirectly, the affairs of the enterprise through a pattern of corrupt activity. The defendant engaged in, conspired to engage in, attempted to engage in, or coerced another to engage in violations of the law including, but not limited to, Trafficking in Heroin, Attempted Trafficking in Heroin, Possession of Heroin, Trafficking Marijuana, Complicity to Traffic Marijuana, as set out in the subsequent counts and incorporated as fully restated herein. At least one of the incidents of corrupt activity is a felony of the THIRD degree or higher. This is in violation of 2923.32(A)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to-wit: ENGAGING IN A PATTERN OF CORRUPT ACTIVITY, constitutes a felony of the FIRST Degree.






