On or about November 3, 2013, in Ottawa County, Ohio, and other Ohio counties, as a continuing course of conduct, aforesaid, did knowingly gain access to, attempt to gain access to, cause access to be granted to, or disseminate information gained from access to the Ohio law enforcement gateway established and operated pursuant to division (C)(1) of section 109.57 of the Revised Code without the consent of, or beyond the scope of the express or implied consent of, the superintendent of the bureau of criminal identification and investigation, contrary to and in violation of Section 2913.04(D) of the Ohio Revised Code, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

This act, to-wit: UNAUTHORIZED USE OF OHIO LAW ENFORCEMENT GATEWAY, constitutes a felony of the FIFTH Degree.





