

The Grand Jurors of the County of Hamilton, in the name and by authority of the State of Ohio, upon their oaths do find and present that **MATTHEW JOHNSON JR AND JOSHUA MCCOY AND ONEA LAPSLEY AND YAHDEA BROWN**, on or about the 24TH or 25TH day of May in the year Two Thousand and Fourteen at the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio aforesaid, **knowingly caused serious physical harm to J.D.**, in violation of Section 2903.11(A)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

SECOND COUNT

The Grand Jurors of the County of Hamilton, in the name and by authority of the State of Ohio, upon their oaths do find and present that **MATTHEW JOHNSON JR AND JOSHUA MCCOY AND ONEA LAPSLEY AND YAHDEA BROWN**, on or about the 24TH or 25TH day of May in the year Two Thousand and Fourteen at the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio aforesaid, **knowingly caused or**

attempted to cause physical harm to E.S., in violation of Section 2903.13(A) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

THIRD COUNT

The Grand Jurors of the County of Hamilton, in the name and by authority of the State of Ohio, upon their oaths do find and present that **MATTHEW JOHNSON JR AND JOSHUA MCCOY AND ONEA LAPSLEY AND YAHDEA BROWN**, on or about the 24TH or 25TH day of May in the year Two Thousand and Fourteen at the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio aforesaid, **knowingly caused or attempted to cause physical harm to A.C.**, in violation of Section 2903.13(A) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.


FOURTH COUNT

The Grand Jurors of the County of Hamilton, in the name and by authority of the State of Ohio, upon their oaths do find and present that **MATTHEW JOHNSON JR AND JOSHUA MCCOY AND ONEA LAPSLEY AND YAHDEA BROWN**, on or about the 24TH or 25TH day of May in the year Two Thousand and Fourteen at the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio aforesaid, **purposely participated with four or more other persons in a course of disorderly conduct in violation of section 2917.11 of the Revised Code, with purpose to commit or facilitate the commission of an offense of violence, to wit: FELONIOUS ASSAULT AND/OR ASSAULT, a violation of section 2903.11 AND/OR 2903.13 of the Ohio Revised Code**, in violation of Section 2917.02(A)(2) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

FIFTH COUNT

The Grand Jurors of the County of Hamilton, in the name and by authority of the State of Ohio, upon their oaths do find and present that **MATTHEW JOHNSON JR AND JOSHUA MCCOY AND ONEA LAPSLEY AND YAHDEA BROWN**, on or about the 24TH or 25TH day of May in the year Two Thousand and Fourteen at the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio aforesaid, by reason of the race, color, religion or national origin of **ANOTHER PERSON OR GROUP OF PERSONS DID VIOLATE 2903.21 of the Ohio Revised Code**, in violation of Section 2927.12(A) of the Ohio Revised Code and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.
