The annual summit brings together survivors, social workers, victim advocates, police officers, lawyers, prosecutors, judges and other community stakeholders to learn how different disciplines are succeeding in the fight against trafficking. In recognition of the diverse backgrounds of attendees and feedback we have received, we are offering some presentation topics for your consideration. Your ideas needn't come from the list below, but you are welcome to submit one of these as your proposal. If you have your own idea, now is the time to submit it!

- Sex Buyers: Demand Reduction Strategies, Case Studies, the Why Behind Buying Sex, John School and Sex Buyer Education Programs
- Identifying and Serving High-Risk Minor Populations: LGBTQ, Runaways, Homeless and Foster-Care Youth, Court Involved Youth, Marginalized Populations, etc.
- Prosecuting Human Trafficking Cases
- Online Exploitation: OnlyFans, Apps, Gaming and Online Recruitment Dynamics
- The Intersection of Domestic Violence and Human Trafficking
- Specialty Court Dockets, Lessons Learned, Safe Harbor and Community Buy-In
- The Connection Between Human Trafficking, Substance Abuse Disorder and Mental Health
- Empowering the Survivor Voice, Avoiding Revictimization, Survivor Leadership and Employment
- Human Trafficking Education Curriculum, Prevention and Response Protocols
- Multidisciplinary Team: In the Survivors Best Interest
- Serving Culturally Diverse Populations and Cultural Competency
- Research and Best Practices

All proposals must be complete and submitted according to the guidelines outlined on this form on or before Sept. 9, 2022. Please email your proposals to HTI@OhioAGO.gov. A workshop submission does not guarantee a place on the program. All proposals will be evaluated by the Human Trafficking Initiative Team; incomplete and unsigned proposals might not be considered. Presenters who are chosen will be notified of acceptance **by Sept. 30, 2022.**

Those selected to present a workshop will be required to submit for review their entire presentation (outline, PowerPoint, etc.) **by Nov. 1, 2022**, to ensure that the material covers current training philosophies and content.

In light of COVID variants, the format of the 2023 HT Summit is still being determined, but a portion may be presented virtually. A final decision will be made this fall, and presenters will be notified accordingly. If the summit is an in-person event, only necessary hotel accommodations will be provided. Regardless of the format, all workshop presenters are required to volunteer their time.
