Through **April 15, 2023**, the Ohio Attorney General's Human Trafficking Commission is accepting applications for a new class of Advisory Commission Ambassadors for the 2023-25 term, beginning in mid-May. Ambassadors offer the commission highly valued insight and expertise.



## INSTRUCTIONS

### Who is eligible?

Ambassador applicants must be survivors of human trafficking (sex/labor, child exploitation, etc.), be at least two years out of the trafficking experience and into the healing journey, have a healthy support system and be interested in impacting how Ohio responds to the trafficking scourge.

### What does an ambassador do?

Ambassadors can expect to provide ongoing input on subcommittee projects, attend quarterly meetings of the Ohio Attorney General's Human Trafficking Commission and advise the commission on opportunities to further improve Ohio's response to human trafficking. The current commission subcommittees: Victim Services, Demand Reduction, Research and Data Gap Analysis, Public Awareness, Health Care, Law Enforcement, and Legal & Legislative.

### What else do I need to know?

Ambassadors will have an opportunity participate in trainings and community outreach. They can expect to be paid for the expertise they provide, to increase professional development, and to have an opportunity for supportive coaching from commission mentors and various other professional agencies in the field.

### How do I submit an application?

To apply for the role of Advisory Commission Ambassador for 2023-25, please complete this application form and submit it **along with two letters of support from co-workers, friends or supporters** by email to **HTI@OhioAGO.gov** (in the subject line, please use "Ambassador Application") or by mail to Ohio Attorney General's Office, Human Trafficking Initiative, 30 E. NOTE: Selected applicants must sign a Safety Plan and Statement of Purpose and Expectations of Responsibilities prior to commencement of term.
