

BCI Laboratory Database Searches PDQ

Ohio BCI's participation in the Paint Data Query (PDQ) database is governed by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP).

I. Database Entry Considerations

In order to consider paint from a crime scene for a PDQ search:

- The paint sample must not be associated with a known paint
- The paint sample must be original automotive paint

Known paint samples are collected by participating agencies, including BCI, and entered into PDQ by RCMP.

II. Database Entry Notification Practices

BCI laboratory reports notify law enforcement agencies if paint samples from crime scene evidence were searched against the PDQ database.

III. Database Search Scope and Frequency

PDQ searches are conducted during the examination of the evidence.

IV. Database Entry Retention

Paint sample entries from crime scene evidence are searched against the PDQ database, they are not retained.
