Subject: **Re-Opening of OPOTA Dormitory Facilities**

The Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy (OPOTA) is pleased to announce the re-opening of its on-campus dormitory facilities for students attending training conducted at the Academy.

Effective immediately, dormitory accommodations will be available **on a space-available basis** for students enrolled in eligible OPOTA training courses at the London campus.

To ensure adequate staffing and facility preparation, the following guidelines will apply:

- Dormitory reservations must be requested **no fewer than ten (10) calendar days** prior to the scheduled start date of the training course.
- Lodging is available **only as space permits** and cannot be guaranteed.
- The lodging fee is **\$30.00 per room, per night**. Single or Double Occupancy available.
- Reservations will be confirmed by OPOTA staff after availability has been verified.
- Police K-9's may not be housed in the dorms unless attending K-9 training.
- Dormitories are only available Monday night through Thursday night.
- The Academy cafeteria is not available currently. Students should plan to provide their own meals while attending training.

Agencies are encouraged to submit lodging requests as early as possible. Requests received fewer than ten (10) days before the course start date may not be accommodated.

Dormitory reservations should be requested during the course registration process or by contacting the OPOTA Registration Office. Questions regarding lodging availability or reservation procedures may be directed to OPOTA Registration at **(740) 845-2700**.

The Academy is pleased to once again offer on-campus lodging as a convenient and economical option for officers traveling to attend training. We appreciate your continued commitment to professional development and look forward to supporting your agency's training needs.
