In an effort to increase students' interest in STEAM (science, technology, engineering, the arts and mathematics) disciplines and professions, the Ohio Attorney General's Office has created a problem-based curriculum on a fourth-grade level that includes video clips of BCI forensic scientists and investigators. The free curriculum invites students to take on the roles of forensic scientists and criminal investigators in solving "crimes."

- Activities that call for learning by trial and error and individual exploration.
- Opportunities for collaboration and social interaction.
