The Ohio Organized Crime Investigations Commission (OOCIC), part of the Ohio Attorney General's Office, offers a wide range of forensic audio and video services to all Ohio law enforcement agencies at no cost to the agency.



Here are the services available:

Forensic video analysis

» The scientific examination, comparison and/or evaluation of video in legal matters

Forensic video clarification

» Sharpening, brightness/contrast, noise reduction, enlarged region of interest, spotlighting, etc.

Forensic image clarification

» Sharpening, brightness/contrast, noise reduction, frame averaging, enlarged region of interest, etc.

Forensic audio clarification

» Noise reduction, gain equalization, speech clarity, etc.

Forensic image comparison

» Comparison of video/still images of clothing, vehicles, tattoos, etc., on scene to known images

Video timelines

» Event chronology in video form for investigations and courtroom demonstrative evidence

Multi-camera synchronized presentations

» Images and videos from cell phones, surveillance cameras, dash cameras, body-worn cameras, etc., synchronized in a single presentation



PDF image sequences

» Frame-by-frame review of video in PDF form

Audio/video synchronization

» Correction of synchronization errors and/or pairing of video with audio from a different source

Animated presentations

» Combining of media (maps, GPS, ShotSpotter, video, audio) into one comprehensive presentation; 3D reconstruction assistance and 3D rendering

Cold-case format conversions

» VHS, 8mm film, cassettes, micro-cassettes, photos to DVD, MP4, WAV, TIFF
