Re: *Concealed Handgun License Reciprocity Agreements*

Dear Mr. Fulkerson:

The Minnesota Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension (BCA) received your letter dated August 8, 2024, inquiring about concealed carry license reciprocity between Ohio and Minnesota.

Minnesota reviews each state's carry permit laws annually to determine whether those laws are similar to Minnesota's. Permits issued in states with similar carry permit laws are recognized in Minnesota. Minnesota determined that Ohio's carry permit laws are similar to Minnesota's. As a result, Minnesota recognizes carry permits issued by Ohio. A list of states whose permits are recognized by Minnesota can be found here:

Because Ohio permits are recognized in Minnesota, no agreement is necessary.
