**Re: Concealed Handgun License Reciprocity Agreements**

Dear Mr. Fulkerson,

Your letter to the Attorney General was forwarded to me for response. You have indicated that by statute, under certain circumstances, the Ohio Attorney General is permitted to enter into reciprocity agreements with other states in regard to recognition of state firearm concealed carry licenses. You have proposed that Ohio enter into such an agreement with New York, if possible.

Thank you for your inquiry. The New York State Attorney General's Office is not authorized under New York Law to enter into any type of reciprocity agreement with regard to firearms licenses. Please do not hesitate to contact me should you have any questions.
