2024 CRIME VICTIM SERVICES









Dear Colleagues,

The Crime Victims Services Section of my office specializes in helping vulnerable Ohioans transition from victims to survivors. One of our vital tools is the Ohio Victims of Crime Compensation Fund, which reimburses the costs of medical expenses, crime-scene cleanup, counseling and other services that crime victims and their families need to heal and move forward with their lives.

Since 1976, the fund has provided more than \$413 million to victims. During fiscal year 2024 – which ran from July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024 – my office paid out 1,977 claims averaging \$3,716 each.

Separately, my office has repeatedly advocated for Congress to bolster and preserve the level of funding in the federal Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Fund by ensuring that financial penalties from deferred prosecution and non-prosecution agreements are treated the same way as penalties resulting from criminal convictions. All such penalties must go to serve and compensate crime victims.

Among our other efforts in FY 2024:

- The Sexual Assault Forensic Exam program reimbursed medical facilities for 5,225 exams at a cost of more than \$3.3 million. The program helps to ensure that evidence is properly collected for use in prosecutions and that patients are not forced to pay extra because they were assaulted.
- Using federal VOCA funding, my office awarded more than \$35 million in grants to 296 community agencies, including trauma-recovery centers operating in Clark, Cuyahoga, Franklin and Lucas counties.
- Crime Victim Services staff members trained more than 2,145 people on an array of topics, including victim compensation, elder abuse, domestic violence, sexual assault and child abuse.
- The 32nd edition of the Two Days in May Conference on Victim Assistance was presented on May 13-14, 2024, drawing 974 attendees.

Per Ohio Revised Code Section 2743.69, this report details the above efforts and many others made by my office to assist crime victims and the advocates who work on their behalf. If you have questions or comments, please contact Crime Victim Services at 614-466-5610.

Introduction

The Ohio Victims of Crime Compensation Fund was created in 1976 to help ease the financial harm inflicted on innocent victims of violent crime. Responsibility for the fund was transferred on July 1, 2000, from the Court of Claims to the Ohio Attorney General's Office. In addition to overseeing the compensation program, the Attorney General's Crime Victim Services Section:

- Administers state and federal grants to support communities' victim-assistance programs.
- Provides education and training to victims, victim advocates and the public.
- Connects victims and those with concerns related to suspected elder abuse and/or crimes with local and state agencies that can work to prevent future acts of abuse and provide resources and guidance to the victims and their families.

Crime Victim Compensation Program

Chapter 2743 of the Ohio Revised Code governs the compensation program, which allows applicants to be reimbursed as much as \$50,000 for economic losses stemming from a violent crime. Economic losses that can be recovered are:

- Medical and related expenses.
- Funeral and burial expenses (up to \$7,500).
- Dependents' economic losses resulting from the death of a victim.
- Crime scene cleanup expenses (up to \$750).
- Compensation for property held as evidence (up to \$750).

Victims cannot receive compensation for pain and suffering or stolen property. Also, the program is a payer of last resort; it does not compensate for economic losses that can be recovered from another source.

To participate in the program, the victim must:

- File a police report and cooperate with law enforcement.
- File an application within three years of the date of the incident.
- Not have engaged in any conduct that substantially contributed to the injuries suffered, except in homicide claims.

The 135th General Assembly, through House Bill 33 (the main operating-budget bill), appropriated additional funds to Crime Victim Services for the current fiscal year.

Crime Victim Compensation Program

The budget appropriated \$9 million to the general revenue fund (GRF) ALI 055441 to supplement other funding sources. HB 110 created this line item with an appropriation of \$2.5 million in FY 2022; no funding for FY 2023 was provided. Before using the funds, the office is required by law to first use federal funds received from the Department of Justice's Office of Victim Services for such expenditures.

Rape crisis centers

The budget appropriated \$15.3 million to GRF ALI 055501 to provide grants to agencies for rape crisis programs. The FY 2024 amount represents an increase of 109.6% over FY 2023 expenditures. The increase will support additional grants and larger awards, with a focus on building capacity in counties without a full range of services.

Domestic violence programs

The budget appropriated \$10 million to GRF 055504 to support additional grants and larger awards, particularly to build capacity in counties without a full range of services. The \$10 million represents an increase of 300%, or \$7.5 million, over the FY 2023 appropriation.

Administrative costs

In terms of the compensation fund, administrative costs for FY 2024 totaled \$5,928,907.

As noted earlier, responsibility for the compensation fund was originally assigned to the Court of Claims, and the fund continues to cover some court expenses, including work on appeals of decisions made by the Attorney General's Compensation Unit (ORC 2743.531). The number of appeals to the Court of Claims decreased by one from FY 2023 (when there were 34) to FY 2024 (33).

The costs to the Attorney General's Office increased 2.5%, from \$5,781,955 to \$5,928,907.

Application and award summary

The Compensation Unit processed 4,593 original compensation claims during the fiscal year. The average award for original claims totaled \$3,381. The total amount paid to crime victims statewide during the fiscal year was \$7,346,554. The unit's goal for the coming year is to make more people aware of the assistance available through the program.

The fund's balance has fluctuated over the past decade, peaking at \$17.3 million (in FY 2016) and dropping as low as \$3.7 million (in FY 2023). The FY 2024 balance increased 37.8% over the previous fiscal year due to the GRF funding.



Attorney fees

Two types of attorney fees are payable under the crime victim compensation statute.

- Under ORC 2743.65, an applicant may seek the assistance of an attorney in filing for compensation or in appealing a decision of the Attorney General's Office. The \$51,505 in attorney fees paid out in the fiscal year represents a 5.4% decrease from the \$54,455 paid out in FY2023.
- Under ORC 2743.51(F)(4), attorneys who successfully assist a claimant with obtaining a protection order or another order to physically separate the victim from the offender may receive reasonable attorney fees not exceeding \$1,000, at a rate not exceeding \$100 per hour. Attorney fees for reasonable travel time incurred to attend court hearings are paid at a rate not exceeding \$30 per hour. The total amount paid to attorneys assisting with protection orders decreased 35.1% in fiscal year 2024, to \$120,278 from \$185,429.

Claims paid by incident type

As in previous years, the majority of the paid claims went to victims of assault (53.2%), followed by awards related to homicide (25.1%) and sexual assault (5.5%).

Subrogation

The Attorney General's Office holds offenders financially accountable for their crimes. The Subrogation Unit's collection efforts against offenders, insurance companies and other liable parties allow for the fund to be reimbursed. The chart below summarizes the results of the Subrogation Unit's efforts, including returning \$526,804 to the fund in FY 2024, a 6.2% increase from the previous fiscal year.

Grants Unit

The Grants Unit administers grants from the State Victims Assistance Act (SVAA) and the federal Victims of Crime Act (VOCA), which are funded by court costs and fees. Recipients generally include domestic-violence shelters, prosecutor-based victim/witness programs, child advocacy centers, and other similar governmental and nonprofit agencies that directly serve crime victims.

The \$46.6 million in VOCA funding provided to Ohio for FY 2024 represents a 6.5% decrease over that of the previous fiscal year. It is significantly less - \$70.7 million - than the \$117.3 million allocated in FY 2019 and a \$21.5 million decrease over the average for the past five fiscal years. During the fiscal year, 324 programs received VOCA funding.

The Grants Unit also administers the Rape Crisis Fund, which in FY 2024 provided more than \$15.1 million to rape crisis centers. Thirty-nine agencies received grants of varying amounts. The funding provides direct victim services — crisis response, hospital advocacy, criminal justice advocacy and more — to survivors of sexual assault statewide. The Ohio Alliance to End Sexual Violence was awarded \$950,000 to provide training and technical assistance to rape crisis centers throughout the state.

Another Grants Unit program, the Ohio's Domestic Violence Fund, aids organizations that provide emergency shelter, counseling and other core services to victims of domestic violence. This fund provided more than \$9.95 million to domestic-violence providers, with 73 agencies receiving an award. The Ohio Domestic Violence Network was awarded \$450,000 to provide training and technical assistance to domestic-violence providers statewide.

The Grants Unit also provides funding to 1-844-OHIO-HELP, a statewide sexual violence helpline started by the Attorney General's Office and operated by OhioHealth's Sexual Assault Response Network of Central Ohio. The 24/7 phone center received 640 calls in FY 2024.

Victim Service Initiatives Unit

The Victim Services Initiatives Unit coordinates training and technical assistance for victim-services professionals, develops resources for them, and provides a way to link organizations to achieve common goals; educates communities about available support services for crime victims; and facilitates training, special events and outreach activities.

During the fiscal year, 2,145 people received some form of training and technical assistance from the unit.

Our Two Days in May Conference on Victim Assistance was presented on May 13-14, 2024 — the 32nd edition of the conference. The 2024 conference, which drew 974 attendees, offered 31 workshops covering an array of topics, including how unmarried mothers address custody rights against abusers; how youth exposed to domestic violence can best be served; how social media has changed the trauma landscape; and how immigrant women of color experience violence. The annual event helps advocates better understand the needs of the diverse population they serve and gives them new strategies for helping victims.

Also in FY 2024, the unit hosted our Zero Abuse/ChildFirst Finding Words Ohio training from Oct. 23 to Oct. 27 in downtown Columbus. This intensive forensic interview curriculum uses guidelines from the American Professional Society on the Abuse of Children and Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, and directly impacts those who work with child victims of sexual abuse who would most likely be served by the

Ohio Crime Victim Compensation Program. Thirty law enforcement officers, prosecutors, forensic interviewers and child-protection professionals completed the training.

The unit is also responsible for printing and distributing information cards to crime victims. In FY 2024, it distributed 9,225 "Crime Victims' Rights" information cards (often called *palm cards*) and 8,675 "Crime Can Be Costly" palm cards, which outline Ohio's Crime Victim Compensation program.

Elder Justice Unit

In February 2024, the Crime Victim Services Section assumed responsibility for the Attorney General Office's Elder Justice Unit. (The EJU had been housed in the Consumer Protection Section.) The EJU helps Ohio's older adults and those who care for them navigate the justice system in cases of abuse and neglect and provides leadership and advocacy to combat elder abuse and exploitation throughout the state. The unit works with law enforcement, prosecutors, adult protective services and communities to:

- Identify, investigate and prosecute cases of elder abuse.
- Improve services for victims.
- Raise awareness of the warning signs of abuse.
- Build local capacity to protect older adults.

The unit leads presentations at trainings, symposiums and outreach events for professionals, including those in law enforcement, social work, adult protective services and the financial industry.

In FY 2024, the unit conducted 42 presentations and trainings, reaching a combined 2,797 people. It opened 264 new matters (calls or contacts from constituents asking for help with EJU's services) and closed 240 (many of which were outstanding from the previous year).

Sexual Assault Forensic Exam Reimbursement program

The Sexual Assault Forensic Exam (SAFE) Reimbursement program is statutorily mandated by Ohio Revised Code Section 2907.28 to cover medical expenses for examinations of patients after a sexual assault, both to ensure the proper collection of evidence for use in prosecutions and to ensure that the patient is not forced to pay. The SAFE Reimbursement Program covers the costs of the evidence kit collection/forensic (genital) examination and the antibiotic prophylaxis to prevent sexually transmitted infections. The program reimbursed medical facilities more than \$3.3 million for 5,225 exams in FY 2024.

In October 2017, the SAFE program began reimbursing hospitals that provide HIV-prevention treatment to victims who might have been exposed to the disease. In collaboration with the Ohio Department of Health, a risk-exposure protocol was developed as part of the state's medical forensic exam process. Ohio Administrative Code Section 109:7-1-02(B) states: "A hospital, children's advocacy center, or other emergency medical facility shall accept payment of the actual amount billed; not to exceed twenty-five hundred dollars, as payment in full for any cost incurred in administration of HIV post-exposure prophylaxis protocol in rule 109:7-1-01 of the Administrative Code."

In FY 2024, the HIV program issued payments exceeding \$1.09 million total.

Sexual Assault Examination Kit Tracking

The Sexual Assault Kit Tracking (SAKT) System is a free, online system that allows individuals who have been sexually assaulted to anonymously view the status of their sexual assault evidence kit. Crime Victim Services offers training and technical assistance statewide on the SAKT, with two trainings conducted in FY 2024. To date, more than 12,741 kits have been tracked in the system. In FY 2024, the system tracked 3,401 kits, including 2,972 (87%) for which laboratory analysis was completed.

Victim Information and Notification Everyday

The Victim Information and Notification Everyday (VINE) program helps crime victims and other concerned citizens access information about the criminal cases and custody status of offenders. VINE provides information on the status of offenders within the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction, the Ohio Department of Youth Services and county jails. Individuals can register to be notified by phone, email, text or TTY device when an offender's custody status changes. Users can register through their participating state toll-free number, VINELink mobile app, VINE MobilePatrol app or <u>VINElink.com</u>.

In FY 2024:

- An average of 464,878 online searches were conducted each month at <u>VINElink.com</u>, the primary registration site for Ohio.
- An average of 13,114 new registrations were logged each month.
- VINELink usage increased 26.2% over comparable 12-month periods, to 3,170,917 from 2,513,001.
- New registrations increased 6.7%, to 157,364 from 147,470.
- Phone inquiries increased 2.5%, to 18,763 from 18,310.
- Email notifications increased 10.2%, to 180,925 from 164,226.
- SMS Text Messaging Notification increased 14.6%, to 174,509 events from 152,306.
- Mobile Patrol searches totaled 2,397,996.
