

A quiet moment in the memorial

Today, during the 24th annual Ohio Peace Officers' Memorial Ceremony, we honor the Ohio officers who gave their lives in the line of duty in 2010 as well as one historical inductee who made the ultimate sacrifice years ago. The Ohio Fallen Officers' Memorial Wall is a lasting tribute to Ohio's 737 officers killed in the line of duty since 1823.

Located on the grounds of the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy, the memorial contains two circular walls. They hold 32 panels bearing the names of Ohio's fallen officers. The annual memorial service reminds us of the supreme sacrifice that too many officers make as they protect the communities they love.

Their quiet dedication and service prompt our respect and admiration for them and their proud profession.

A third circular sitting wall gives visitors a place to rest and contemplate the principles embodied in the memorial.

Nestled in a park-like setting, the Ohio Fallen Officers' Memorial features walkways leading to breaks between the three walls. An eternal flame in the center symbolizes our lasting memories of these brave peace officers. It burns constantly, illustrating the honored peace officers' steadfast vow to put themselves in harm's way to protect us all.



Chief Carl E. Worley Ross Township Police Department



Honored during the May 5, 2011, Ohio Peace Officers' Memorial Ceremony for having lost his life in the line of duty.

Chief Carl E. Worley of the Ross Township Police Department was investigating a string of burglaries when he suffered a fatal heart attack Jan. 26, 2010.

Chief Worley was working with officers from the Ross Township Police Department, Butler County Sheriff's Office, and Hamilton Police Department to track the burglary suspect. Doors to at least two homes in the area had been kicked in, and officers discovered suspicious footprints. Chief Worley was investigating the footprints when a radio call alerted him to another possible break-in.

Chief Worley advised a dispatcher that he was returning to his vehicle to assist. A few minutes later, he was found unresponsive in his cruiser. Medics were dispatched, and Chief Worley was transported to Fort Hamilton Hospital, where emergency room personnel determined he had suffered a fatal heart attack.

A member of the Ross Township Police Department for nearly 13 years, including seven years as chief, he is survived by his wife, Kathy; brother and sister-in-law, Jack and Barbara Worley; sister and brother-in-law, Janice and Don Baird; nieces and nephews; and many other relatives and friends.



Trooper Andrew C. Baldridge Ohio State Highway Patrol



Honored during the May 5, 2011, Ohio Peace Officers' Memorial Ceremony for having lost his life in the line of duty.

Trooper Andrew C. Baldridge of the Ohio State Highway Patrol was responding to a call for assistance when he lost his life in a car accident Feb. 4, 2010.

Trooper Baldridge and his field training officer, Trooper Mark McLaughlin, had finished clearing a traffic stop when they received a call for assistance from the Wyandot County Sheriff's Office. While en route, the patrol car Trooper Baldridge was driving overturned several times, trapping both men inside. Trooper McLaughlin alerted dispatch to the accident and was able to exit the cruiser. Trooper Baldridge remained trapped, unconscious, and unresponsive. Rescue personnel arrived and removed Trooper Baldridge from the cruiser and initiated life-saving efforts; however, due to the severe injuries he sustained in the crash, those efforts were unsuccessful.

Trooper Baldridge graduated from the Ohio State Highway Patrol Academy with the 149th class in December 2009. He had served the patrol for two months prior to the accident.

He is survived by his parents, Rick and Marcele Baldridge; sister and brother-in-law, Elizabeth and Robert Williams; brother and sister-in-law, Matthew and Chelsea Baldridge; niece and nephew, Addison Baldridge and Brayden Williams; and many other relatives and friends.



Officer Thomas F. Patton II Cleveland Heights Police Department



Honored during the May 5, 2011, Ohio Peace Officers' Memorial Ceremony for having lost his life in the line of duty.

Officer Thomas F. Patton II of the Cleveland Heights Police Department collapsed while pursuing a felony assault suspect on foot March 13, 2010.

Responding to a radio broadcast from an officer in pursuit of a suspect wanted for felony assault on a police officer, Officer Patton helped other officers establish a perimeter and joined the chase in a snow-covered wooded area. Officer Patton collapsed while heading toward other officers as they took the suspect into custody. Efforts by fellow officers and rescue and hospital personnel to revive him were unsuccessful.

Officer Patton served the Cleveland Heights Police Department for 9½ years. He was a third-generation police officer with relatives who have retired from and currently serve as members of the Cleveland Police Department.

He is survived by his fiancée, Tricia Sindelar; daughter, Kayleigh; father, State Senator Thomas F. Patton; sisters and brothers-in-law, Shannon and Duke Southworth, Erin and Michael Graziani, Meghan and Anthony Schepis, Brigid Patton, and Kathleen Patton; and grandmother Joan Kessler. He was preceded in death by his mother, Evelyn Patton, and grandparents, John and Rita Patton and Kent Kessler.



Sergeant James A. Kerstetter Elyria Police Department



Honored during the May 5, 2011, Ohio Peace Officers' Memorial Ceremony for having lost his life in the line of duty.

Sergeant James A. Kerstetter of the Elyria Police Department was shot while confronting a suspect March 15, 2010.

A mother called 911 to report that a man had been exposing himself to her child. Sergeant Kerstetter arrived at the suspect's residence, made contact, and entered the home. The suspect fired on Sergeant Kerstetter, who radioed for backup and reported that he had been shot. Responding officers shot and killed the suspect as he attempted to flee the home. Sergeant Kerstetter succumbed to his injuries at Elyria Memorial Hospital.

Sergeant Kerstetter served the Elyria Police Department for 15½ years and also was a guest instructor for the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy. Prior to joining the Elyria police force, he worked for the Lorain County Sheriff's Office as a corrections officer and then deputy sheriff.

He is survived by his wife, Tammy; three daughters, Misty, Shelby, and Bailey; parents, James and Carol Kerstetter; three sisters and two brothers-in-law, Kathy Kerstetter, Kelly and Tim Strickler, and Kristy and Gordon Sawyers; several nieces and nephews; motherand father-in-law, Sandra McCrann and William Maroney; and many other relatives and friends.


