APPROVAL, LEASE EXECUTED BY THE MASONIC TEMPLE COMPANY OF ZANESVILLE, OHIO, GRANTING THE DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS ROOMS IN THE MASONIC TEMPLE OF SAID CITY, FOR ELEVEN MONTHS, AT \$45.00 PER MONTH.

DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval a lease executed by the Masonic Temple Company of Zanesville, Ohio, granting to you as Director of Highways and Public Works for the use of the Department of Industrial Relations, rooms 418, 419 and 420 on the fourth floor of the Masonic Temple of said city, for the term of eleven months, beginning on the first day of August, 1926.
