DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my examination and approval a certain lease in triplicate, executed by one Pearl Colby Wonner, heir-at-law and administratrix of the estate of S. Lee Colby, leasing and demising to you, as Director of the Department of Public Welfare, for the use of the Madison Home, certain lands therein described in Madison Township, Lake County, Ohio. The term of said lease is for the season of the year 1929, but not to extend beyond the 15th day of December, 1929, and the rental to be paid for the leasing of said lands is the sum of \$42.00 payable in advance.
