On Tuesday, June 7th, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Aja Chung with SA Shawn Rowley and SA Mathew Austin were assigned to assist the Franklin County Sheriff's Office (FCSO) with an officer involved shooting incident. SA Chung was requested by SA Rowley (BCI CSU lead agent) to respond to the FCSO SWAT building to document the involved deputies.

At 2149 hours, SA Chung photographed two FCSO Deputies, **Sector** and **Sector** involved in the investigation. Both deputies were wearing their agency issued external vests that had 'Sheriff' in yellow on the front and back of the vest and their duty belts. Both deputies were dressed in green battle dress uniform (BDU) style pants and a baseball cap. SA Chung photographed and collected the pistols as listed below:

It should be noted both pistols had a Streamlight Tactical light affixed to the rail of their pistols and a Delta Point Pro red dot rear sight. The Streamlight lights and red dot rear sights were removed and given back to both Deputies. The two extra magazines each deputy carried on their vest was photographed for documentation only as both deputies confirmed they did not reload their pistols during the incident.

SA Chung concluded her documentation of the FCSO Deputies at 2215 hours. SA Chung turned over the two items to SA Rowley on June 8th, 2022 at 0159 hours.
