APPROVAL, LEASE OF RESERVOIR LANDS AT RUSSELL'S
POINT, OHIO.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, April 9, 1937.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval a number of reservoir land leases in triplicate, among which were those hereinafter designated which granted and demised to the several lessees therein named parcels of reservoir lands at Russell's Point, Ohio.

The leases here referred to are each and all for a stated term of fifteen years and provide for an annual rental of six per centum upon the appraised value of the parcel of land covered by the lease.
