Narrative:

On Monday, November 17, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agents Richard Ward and Matt Collins returned to 4175 Brush Creek to search the woodline in the area where the OSHP trooper reportedly discharged their patrol rifle. During the previous search conducted from Saturday into Sunday (11/14-11/15), several casings were unaccounted for. Because the scene had already been released, Adams County Sheriff's Office Sergeant Randy Walters obtained consent from Tabitha Lindner (wife of Christopher Lindner) to re-enter the property.

During the search, thirteen (13) additional .223 casings were recovered along a creek bank approximately thirty to forty-five feet north of the other casings previously located. The casings were photographed (attached below) and submitted for comparison purposes.
