**Narrative:**

On Monday, January 05, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Joe Lamping (SA Lamping) received an email from the Ashtabula County Coroner's Office (ACCO). The correspondence consisted of the autopsy report for Jerry Pegram (Pegram). SA Lamping reviewed the report and noted the following:

ACCO provided three documents in regard to their investigation of Pegram's death: ACCO Investigator Report<sup>1</sup>, the full autopsy report from the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Office, and a signed verdict from the Ashtabula County Coroner Catherine Bishop, D.O. (Doctor Bishop). The information deemed to be the most relevant to this inquiry is summarized below for the convenience of the reader. However, as the author is not a doctor, it is suggested that the reports be viewed in their entirety to ensure no pertinent information has been omitted or described out-of-context.

This autopsy report was authored by David Dolinak, M.D. The "CAUSE OF DEATH" for Pegram was listed as '██████████'. The "MANNER OF DEATH" was listed as '|██████████'. In the report filed by Ashtabula County Coroner Doctor Bishop she listed Pegram's manner of death as '██████████'.

The "DIAGNOSIS" section of the report listed the following relevant information:






