SUMMARY:

On Tuesday, July 19, 2022, BCI Special Agents (SAs) Ashley Ornelas, Larry Hootman and SAS Ed Lulla assisted the Ohio State Patrol with the processing of an apartment located at 4853 Westchester Drive, Building A, Youngstown, Ohio 44515 in regard to an officer involved critical incident. The scene was photographed as it was found and evidence was collected. The scene was further documented using a FARO laser scanner.

DETAILS:

On Tuesday, July 19, 2022 at 1656hrs, SA Ornelas was contacted by SAS Ed Lulla and was requested to assist the Ohio State Patrol with the processing of an apartment in regard to an officer involved critical incident.

On Tuesday, July 19, 2022 at 1802hrs, SA Ornelas arrived on scene. SA Ornelas was advised that at approximately 1500hrs on July 19, 2022, the Ohio State Patrol was asked to take over a barricaded subject situation. Prior to troopers breaching the apartment, the subject, Imonie Hackett, allegedly fired a weapon. A sniper posted in the laundry room of 4853 Westchester Drive, Building A, Youngstown, Ohio 44515 fired one (1) round striking Imonie.

The laundry room was in a multi-story, brick apartment building with the main entrance facing south. The laundry room was located on the first floor on the north side of the building. The washer and dryer had been placed together in front of the window with one (1) side open. A rifle was located on top of the machines. The scene was photographed as found (Figure 1, Laundry Room Overall).
