ASSIGNMENT:

On Thursday June 2, 2022, while on duty, I received a call from Homicide Detective Sergeant Reese #9266 stating that I needed to respond to 3495 E.98th St because CMHA was involved in a shooting. I was then sent the following information on a text:

*FULL UDFIT @ 3495 E.98th St. CMHA involved in shooting---
50yr male gsw to chest. CMHA officer sustained injuries. CAD 155158*

I then met with Detective Powell #2062 and Detective Cramer #346 at the JC, 6th floor, Homicide Unit, after which we proceeded to the scene and commenced with the following investigation.

EVIDENCE:

While on scene at the address of 3495 E.98th Street, I was asked by Sergeant Rini #9051 to take possession of the (2) two involved CMHA Officer's Axon Wearable Camera Systems (WCS). I was then instructed to respond to the CMHA Police and Security Headquarters building located at 5715 Woodland Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44104, to download the recorded video of the incident.
