**Summary:**

On November 12, 2025, Special Agent Ryan Emahiser of the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation received a warrant to search the contents of the below listed item. This item was to be analyzed for evidence pertaining to the crime of Felonious Assault regarding the subject Brad Bailey.

**Submitted Items:**

003 – Mobile Phone – Apple iPhone 16 Pro – A3083

**Details:**

Item 3: Item 3 is an Apple manufactured mobile phone model A3083 (iPhone 16 Pro). The International Mobile Equipment Identity (IMEI) numbers associated with Item 3 are 354078669437178 and 354078664685706 and the serial number is DKGJFXV4T5. Item 3 has an advertised internal storage capacity of 128 Gigabytes (GB) and is not capable of additional storage. Item 3 is locked with a six (6) digit passcode which was provided (passcode [REDACTED]). Item 3 was placed into airplane mode to suspend wireless communications. The device was connected to a forensic tool capable of obtaining a full file system extraction from the device. The extraction was then loaded into Cellebrite Inseyets Physical Analyzer, a software package that converts the data to an easily readable format.

**Findings:**

Item 3: The Apple ID associated with Item 3 is runitup1983@icloud.com. The phone number associated with Item 3 is 234-926-0412. The owner name associated with Item 3 is Brad Bailey. The last Integrated Circuit Card Identifier (ICCID) associated with Item

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3 is 89012807331680575019. Attachment A contains one (1) Cellebrite UFDR file for the timeframe of October 11, 2025 – October 12, 2025. Attachment B contains one (1) Cellebrite UFDR file. In order to view the content of the UFDR files, double-click the CellebriteReader.exe and the UFDR will auto populate. Once the Cellebrite Reader is open, the content can be examined and any additional reports can be generated.

**Conclusion:**

A copy of Attachments A – B were electronically provided to the agency for further review by the case investigator.
