GENTLEMEN:—I acknowledge receipt of your letter of January 18, 1922, transmitting for my examination proposed lease in triplicate to the American Steel and Wire Company for a portion of the northern division of the Ohio canal between what is known as the Boston lock and the Outlet lock of said canal into the Cuyahoga river.

I have noted the statements in your letter regarding the circumstances under which the lease is being made, and have also noted that the valuation fixed for the land embraced in the lease is \$50,000 and that the basis of computation for water rentals is six per cent on a valuation of \$200,000; the annual rental under the lease being \$15,000.

I have carefully examined the lease with special reference to sections 431, 13965 and following, and 14009 and following, of the General Code. I find said lease correct in form and legal and I am therefore returning it with my approval endorsed thereon.
